What garbage hauler can I use?

You may use the garbage hauler of your choice.

Who picks up recycling?

The City has a contract with Waste Management for recycling providing for a cost savings to residents. Recycling fees are paid for with your property taxes at a fee of \$2.79 per month.

What size outbuildings can I have?

Sizes of outbuildings depend upon the size parcel. A list of allowed sizes per acreage can be found under "Property/Land Use" on the City's website.

How do I report potholes?

There is a Road Issue Reporting Form on the City's website under "Road Facts".

Where do I get a building permit?

You may download an application from the City's website under "City Documents" and submit it to the City.

Where do I get a burn permit?

The City has two Fire Wardens that are listed under "City Personnel".
