RESOLUTION NO. 2026-14**

**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DONATION OF NATIVE TREE AND SHRUB  
PLANTINGS AT BASS LAKE PARK  
AND AUTHORIZING WORK ON BEHALF OF THE CITY**

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statutes Section 465.03 provides that donations to the City be accepted by resolution of the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Kevin Helmer, has offered to donate native trees, shrubs and materials valued at \$2,725.80 to plant an area approximately 30 feet by 150 feet near the northwest shoreline of Bass Lake Park, a City owned public park (PID 10.030.21.33.0002) as depicted in the Helmer screening concept plan ; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Helmer is further donating his time, knowledge and skills to hand plant and maintain said native trees and shrubs (“Donation of Services”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Grant will have no obligation to maintain or replace the trees or shrubs; and

**WHEREAS**, all such donations noted above will be contributed to the city for the benefit of its citizens, as required by law; and


**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that it is appropriate to accept the donations offered; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Helmer shall not be an employee, subcontractor or agent of the City while providing the Donation of Services.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANT, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA** that it does hereby accept the donation of native trees and shrubs and the Donation of Services from Mr. Kevin Helmer with gratitude.

**FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City does hereby authorize Mr. Kevin Helmer to provide and hand plant native trees and shrubs at Bass Lake Park however Mr. Helmer shall not be considered an employee, subcontractor or agent of the City.
