RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AUTHORITY OF THE PERSONNEL COMMITTEE


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Grant recognizes the need for a Personnel Committee to facilitate the timely and effective decision-making needed while the City undertakes the actions necessary to hire a new City Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it beneficial to establish a Personnel Committee to review personnel matters, including but not limited to undertaking efforts related to hiring a new City Administrator and other staff as directed by the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANT, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA as follows:

1. A Personnel Committee is hereby reaffirmed as an advisory body to the City Council of the City of Grant, tasked with undertaking the all the necessary efforts needed to bring forth City Administrator/Clerk and Treasurer/Deputy City Clerk candidates to the Council for consideration.
2. The Personnel Committee shall consist of two (2) members of the City Council as confirmed by the City Council.
3. The Personnel Committee shall serve in an advisory capacity only for determining the City Administrator/Clerk and Treasurer/Deputy City Clerk; full City Council action is needed for final interview, if applicable, and final contract approval.
4. The Personnel Committee shall consist of Mayor Giefer and Councilmember Cornett.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
