AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 28, STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES TO ADD ARTICLE IV RIGHT-OF-WAY MANAGEMENT FOR THE CITY OF GRANT, MINNESOTA

On March 6, 2017 the City of Grant adopted an ordinance to amend Chapter 28 to add Article IV Right-of-Way Management to allow the City to manage users within the city's rights-of-way in the City of Grant, Minnesota.
